## 2019 Morgante Nero d'Avola-Sicily, Italy

Sicily is a wonderful source of diverse, high quality red wines. Steadily increasing in popularity over the past few decades, Italy's fourth largest wine-producing region is finally receiving the accolades it deserves and shining in today's global market. Of particular note are the various microclimates of Europe's largest volcano, Mount Etna, where vineyards grow on drastically steep hillsides and varying aspects to the Ionian Sea. Nero d'Avola is the most widely planted red variety, and is great either as single varietal bottling or in blends with other indigenous varieties or even with international ones. In Sicily, Nero d'Avola is the undisputed red grape for wines of excellence, and it is this vine that the Morgante family has always cultivated. The winery is located in the pristine countryside of southern Sicily, a hilly region located about 1200-1800 feet above sea level and just 45 miles from the splendid Valley of the Temples of Agrigento. This wine shows aromas of ripe black cherries and blackberries accompanied by hints of vanilla, peppery spice, and smoke. On the palate, abundant flavors of ripe fruit and exotic spices are balanced by a pleasing acidity and silky tannins. 92 PTS JS

## 2021 Nicosia Frappato di Vittoria Sabbie di Sutta- Sicily, Italy

In respecting a land that has been in their family for over 120 years, Cantine Nicosia has obtained several organic certifications and are also part of VIVA for sustainability. Frappato is one of Sicily's exciting indigenous red It makes a lively single varietal wine as well with charming strawberry, pomegranate, white pepper and violet qualities. Frappato is a likely descendant of the Tuscan Ciliegiolo grape, which is named after the Italian word for cherry. In the glass, this wine shines a vivid ruby red with violet highlights. Frappato is a typical grape variety of the south-eastern part of Sicily. Made from only organic and carefully selected grapes, this wine is distinctive for the pleasant aroma of red fruit, raspberries and blueberries. Its taste is lively, fresh and smooth. The palate is lively, fruity and smooth, with refined tannins and a distinctive minerality 90 PTS Vinous
